COURSE MAP



14+ years: Run 1500 meters along Noosa's pristine Main Beach before swimming 750 meters in the sheltered, warm ocean waters of Laguna Bay. Finish your race with another 1500 meter beach run before crossing the finish line.

8-13 years: Run 500 meters along Noosa Main beach, a 200 meters swim in the bay, and final 500 meter dash to the finish line!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. Do I need to bring a swim cap?

A. Swim caps will be provided on the day; this helps to categorise the swimming groups.

Q. Am I too old to compete?

A. All participants ages 8 years plus are welcome to participate. Run Swim Run, is competitive combined with having fun.

Q. Do all swimmers start at once?

A. The Race will start as a wave start with 8-13-year-olds starting first and continuing through to the older age group.

A. There will be bike racks in the woods, where bikes can go after the race.

Q. What happens after the race

A. Athletes will get a free coffee in the Noosa Woods and get to catch up with one another.

Q. Do I need to get body numbering?

A. There is no body numbering for this event. The athlete will receive a bib instead.

Q. Do I need to get a number on my bike?

A. Bike's will not get a sticker

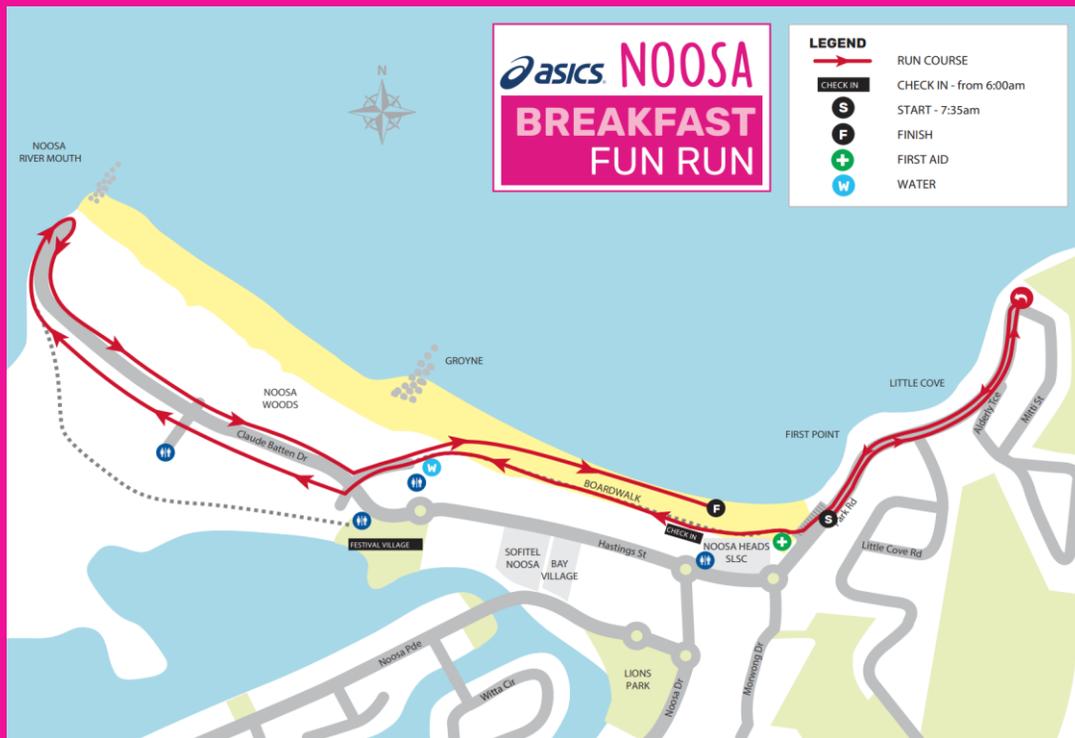

There is one Aid Station serving water at the halfway point as you pass the Groyne.

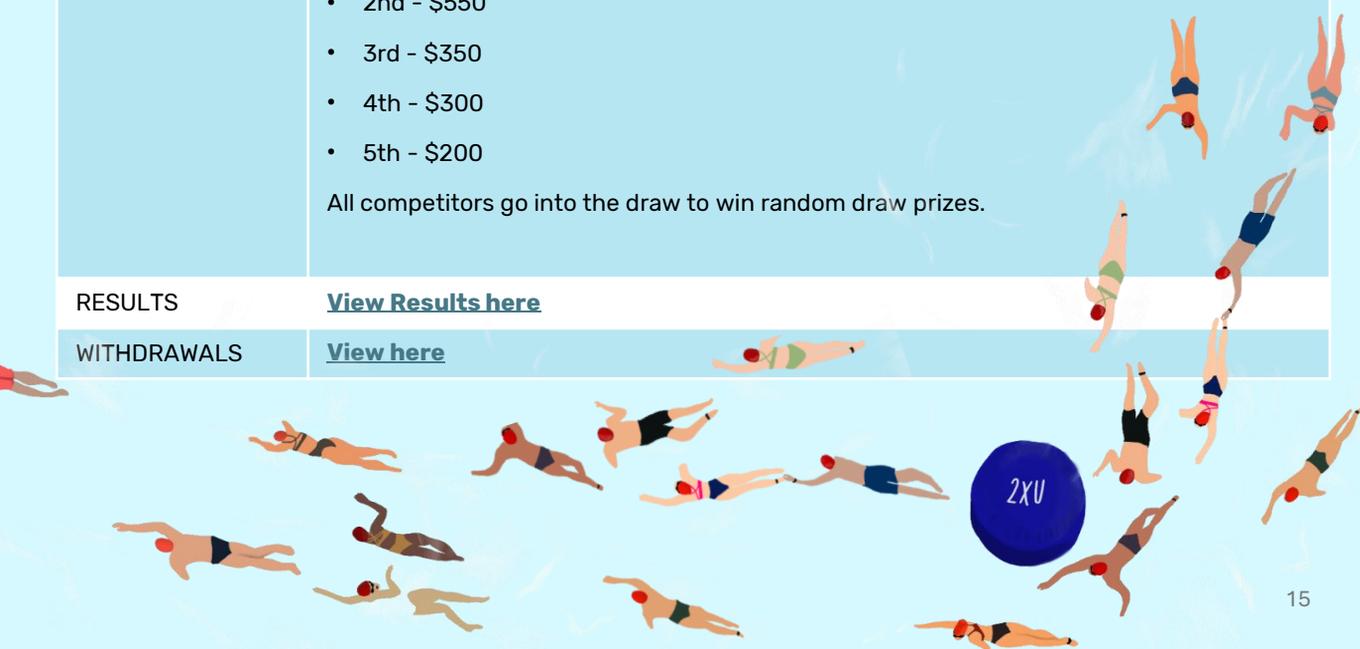

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: How do I complete the M-shaped course?

A: The 2XU Noosa Ocean Swim features an M-shaped course. Participants begin by running into the water and swimming the first leg. After exiting the water, they run along the beach before re-entering the ocean to complete the second swim leg. The course finishes with a final run up the beach to the finish line.

Q. Do I need to bring a swim cap?

A. 2XU swim caps will be provided on the day; this helps to categorise the swimming groups.

Q. Can Friends and Family come support me on the beach?

A. Absolutely! We invite everyone to come down to the start and finish are to cheer on their loved ones and see the action.

What race morning looks like

Before You Arrive

Please have the following items ready:

- ✔ **QR Code** (for check-in)

Arrival & Check-In

- 📍 **Location:** Chaplin Park (near Noosa Yacht & Rowing Club, Noosaville)
- 🕒 **Time:** Arrive by **6:00 AM** (or earlier, please keep in mind lots of people will be trying to check-in)

📢 Important

To avoid crowding, **only one parent or caregiver** should accompany each child. At the Check-In station, you will receive:

- 📄 **Race Singlet**
- 📄 **Bib**
- 📌 **Pins**
- 🧢 **Swim Cap**
- 📄 **Parent/Caregiver Wristband**

(Please put this on immediately – it helps us identify who is responsible for each child during the event.)

Get Ready

- 📌 After check-in, find an open space away from the check-in lines and pin bib to the provided singlet (or another singlet/shirt)

📄 **1234** Stick the bike sticker on the middle of the bike handlebars.

Body Marking

- 📄 Next, proceed to the designated area where staff will write your child's **bib number on their arm**. This is essential for identifying them during the swim.

Transition Area Setup

- 🚲 **Only one parent/caregiver** is allowed to assist the child in the transition area. Please help your child:
 - 👛 **Ensure helmet is on and done up.** A technical official will check helmet and do a quick bike safety check at transition entry.
 - 🚲 **Rack your bike by age category.** Our staff/volunteers will help you find the right spot.
 - 📄 **Place gear to the left of their bike**, including:
 - Running Shoes *(children should not wear shoes to the swim start)*
 - Race Singlet with bib attached
 - Any extra clothing
 - Bike helmet

Once setup is complete, **parents/caregivers must leave the transition area** and head to the spectator zone. Staff will be available to assist children during the race.

Post-Event Instructions

- 🎉 After the race:
 - Parents/caregivers must **show their wristband** to staff to collect their child.
 - 🚫 **Bikes cannot be removed** from the transition area until **Special Tri athletes** have finished and cleared the area. This is for everyone's safety.

Stick Around for a Prize!

- 🎁 Don't rush off! Stay for the **Random Prize Draw** for your chance to win a prize. Remember to only give us your ticket under your bib when our staff ask for it.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q: Can I have a caregiver run with me?

A: Yes, absolutely! Caregivers are welcome to run alongside participants to provide support throughout the event.

Q: Does my caregiver need to sign up?

A: No formal registration is required. Caregivers (buddies) will simply need to sign a waiver on the day of the event.

Q: Can a caregiver help during transitions?

A: Your Buddy is there to support their athlete every step of the way, including during transitions between race legs.

Q: What if I don't want to compete in all three legs of the race?

A: That's completely okay! Just speak with the event team onsite, and they'll help tailor your participation to suit your needs.

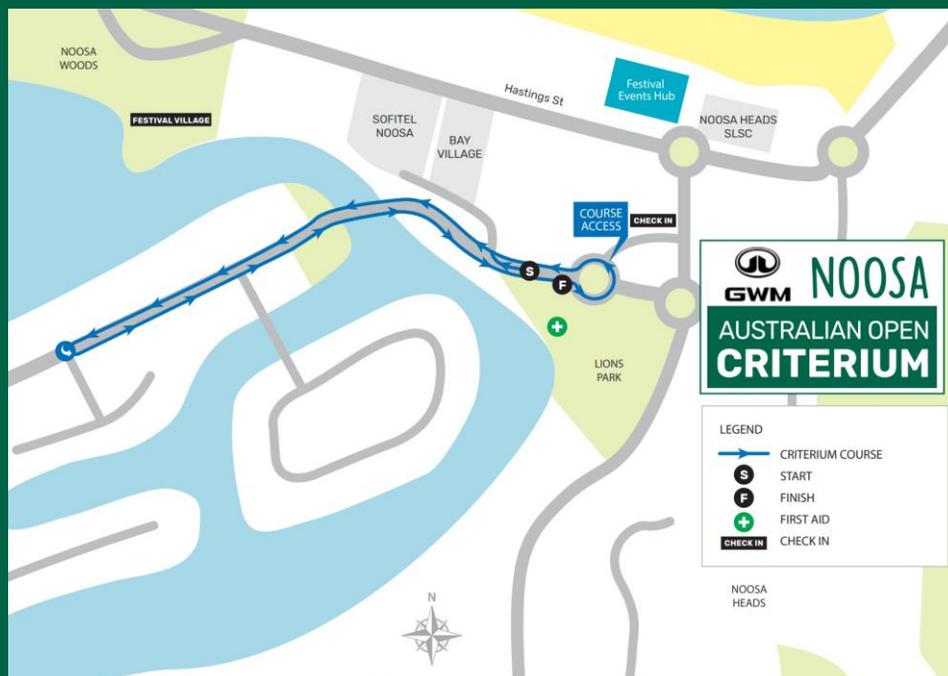

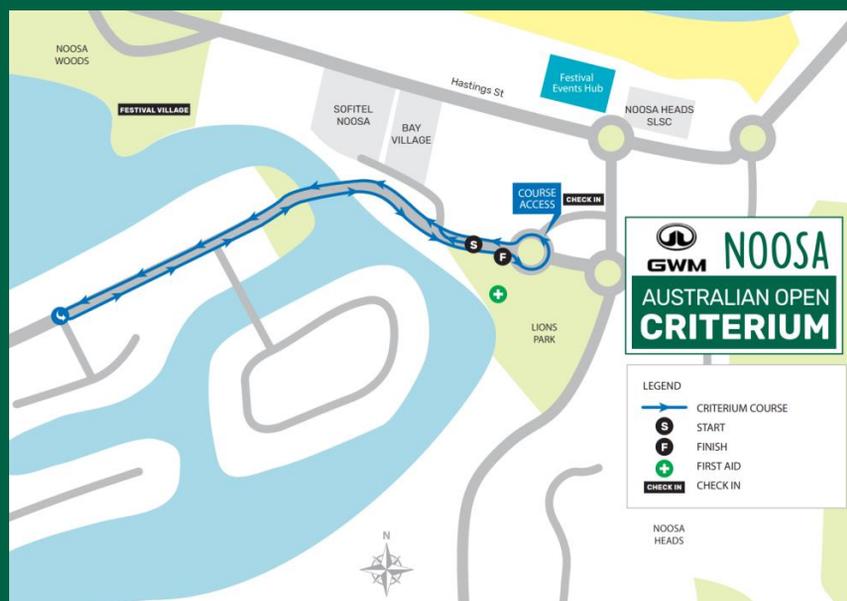
